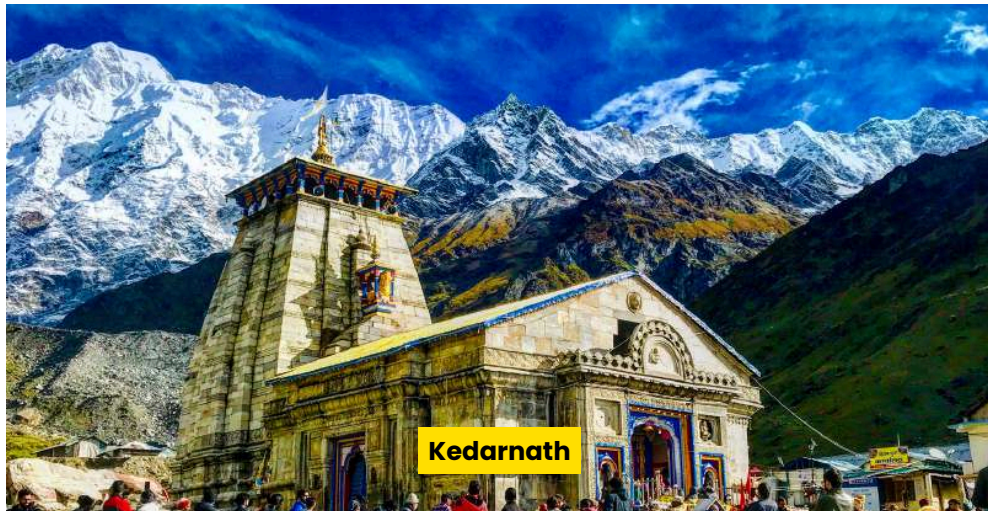

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CHARDHAM YATRA 2025 BY ROAD

OVERVIEW

The four pilgrimage destinations of Yamunotri, Gangotri, Kedarnath, and Badrinath, altogether known as Char Dham, are situated in the mighty Himalayas. This Chardham is also popular by the name of Chota Chardham. These pilgrimage sites attract the greatest number of pilgrims each year, making them the most important religious travel places in Northern India. The pilgrimage traditionally begins in the west and ends in the east. As a result, the Char Dham Yatra begins from Yamunotri and continues to Gangotri, Kedarnath, and Badrinath.

Each of these four sites is dedicated to a different god. Yamunotri is devoted to the Goddess Yamuna and flows along with pilgrims to the scenic Rawai Valley's also known as Barkot. The goddess Yamuna is believed to be the daughter of Sun and the twin sister of Yama which means the God of death. It is also said that the bath in the Yamuna can cleanse all the sins and also protect them from a painful death and also in Hindu mythology Yamuna is in higher ranks of divine. A bath in the Yamuna's waters is thought to preserve the devotee from an untimely death.

Gangotri is a Hindu pilgrimage site devoted to the Goddess Ganga. The shrine stands on the banks of the River Bhagirathi, another name for the Ganga, which gets its name from the legend of ancient King Bhagirath's penance, which brought her down from heaven. River Ganga is considered as the most sacred and purest river in India.

Kedarnath is a part of the Panch Kedar and is devoted to Lord Shiva. It is the northernmost Jyotirlinga and is located near the origin of the Mandakini River. Kedarnath is one of the most esteemed temples of India by the Hindus and holds major significance in the Hindu religion, as Kedarnath is one of the Chota Char Dham and also one of the twelve Jyotirlingas. The ancient name of Kedarnath is 'Kedar Khand'. Kedarnath, located at an

altitude of 3,580 meters near the Chorabari glacier, the source of the Mandakini river with a backdrop of Kedarnath peak, Kedar Dome, and other Himalayan peaks, is dedicated to Lord Shiva.

Lord Vishnu is worshipped in Badrinath. It is located on the Alaknanda River's bank. Lord Vishnu meditated here, according to mythology, while his spouse Lakshmi took the form of a berry (Badri) tree to provide him with shade. Lord Vishnu was so moved by Goddess Laxmi's deed of love that he named the location Badrikashram after her. This temple is only open from May to October, attracting millions of pilgrims during that time. It is also one of the Char Dham yatra temple.

Day to Day Itinerary

Day 1:- (Delhi - Haridwar: 230 Kms 05-06 Hrs Approx.)

Pickup around 10 O'clock from Akshardham Metro station Our executive will assist you from here and drive towards Haridwar. Reach Haridwar by afternoon check-in in your hotel and visit Har-ki-Pauri means the feet of Lord Vishnu. Har- Ki-Pauri. People also visit here at Haridwar for Kumbh mela and Kanwer Mela be the part of Ganga Aarti. Dinner and overnight stay in hotel.



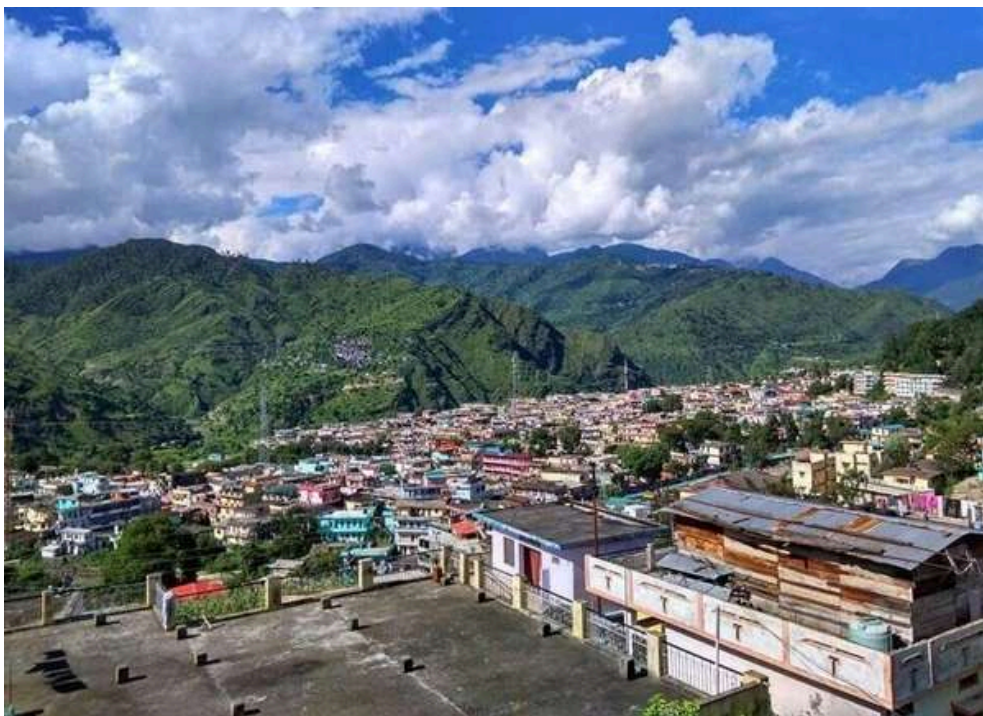
Day 2: (Haridwar – Barkot/ janki chatti : 195 Kms 05-06 Hrs Approx.)

Drive from Haridwar to Barkot. During the way vehicle will halt at Restaurant/Dhaba. En-route you also explore Dehradun the Capital city of Uttarakhand , famous Kempty waterfall at Mussoorie Reach Barkot by afternoon check-in Hotel. Evening free for leisure explore barkot. Dinner and overnight stay at Barkot.



Day 3: (Barkot- Janakichatti: 31 Kms 01 Hrs one way)

Drive to Janakichatti-Yamunotri Darshan (05-06 KMs one-way trek). On an average the trek takes around 2 hours. Pony and porter are available during the trek (self paid). Visit Yamunotri temple do Darshan at Yamunotri Dham explore the valley, trek down and drive back to Barkot. Dinner and Overnight stay at Hotel .



Day 4: (Barkot – Uttarkashi: 100 Kms 03Hrs Approx.)

After breakfast drive to Uttarkashi enjoy the view of majestic mountains and river Bhagirathi. Visit Uttarkashi. Uttarkashi is famous for Hindu Temple, Visit Kashi Vishwanath Temple. Vishwanath Temple is one of the oldest shiva temple Do darshan at Vishwanath Temple explore the Uttarkashi city visit local market. Dinner and overnight stay at the Hotel.



Day 5: Uttarkashi - Gangotri - Uttarkashi: 198 Kms 07 Hrs One-way)

Early morning after breakfast drive towards Gangotri, Darshan and Pray at the temple, take holy dip and collect Maa Ganga water for family. Spend some time at this beautiful place then back to Move towards Uttarkashi. En-route If time permits, we will take halt at Harsil village viewpoint for sightseeing. Harshil is beautiful mountain village famous for apple produce after that we will back to the hotel dinner and overnight stay.



Day 6: (Uttarkashi – Guptkashi / Sonprayag : 226 Kms 07 -08 Hrs)

After breakfast Drive towards Guptkashi, watch holy river Mandakini flowing beside our way. Hear the ancient tales of Pandavas and Shiva from the locals. Visit Ardh Narishwar Temple in Guptakashi. Dinner and overnight stay at Hotel in Sonprayag/Guptkashi.



Day 7: (Sita pur/ Guptkashi /Sonprayag – Gaurikund – Shri Kedarnath Ji)

Today we will visit Shri Kedarnath Temple. We trek for 21 km or hire pony, porter or palki here (self paid). Helicopter service is also available to reach the temple (self paid). After reaching, perform puja and abhishek of Lord Shiva (Kedarnath Ji). Visit the Bhairav Nath Temple which has its own importance for the pilgrims visiting here. Dinner and overnight stay at Hotel in Kedarnath Valley.



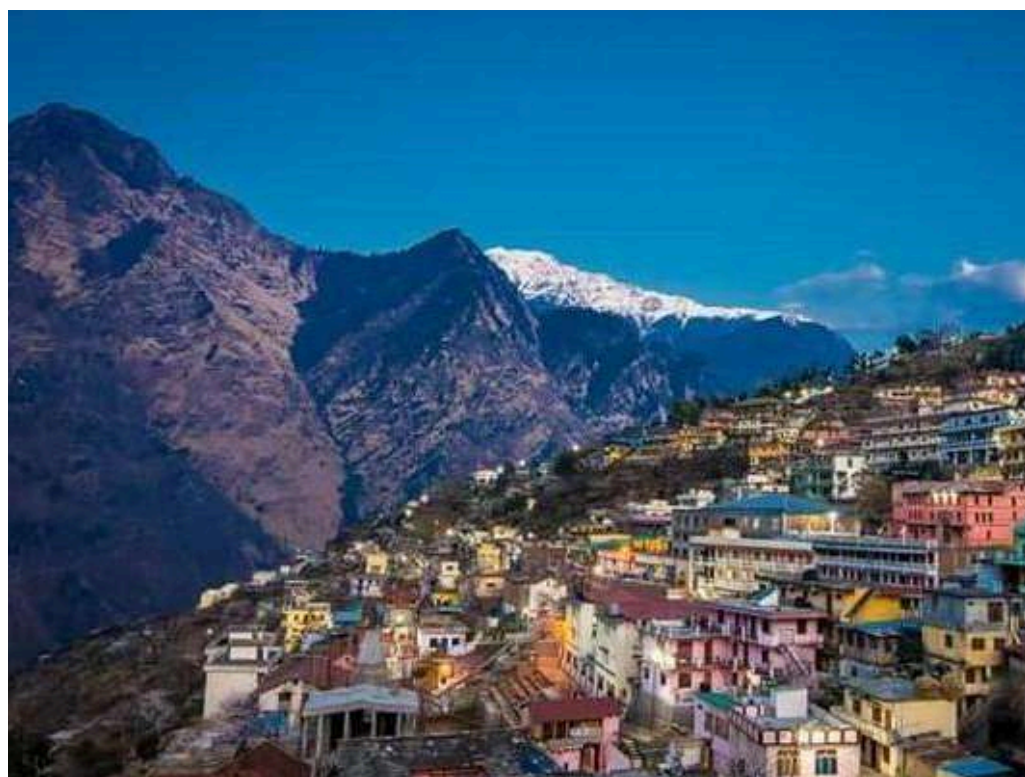
Day 8: (Shri Kedarnath Ji - Guptkashi /Sonprayag/ Sitapur)

Early morning, witness the sun rise from Kedarnath Valley. Watch the snow covered peak. After breakfast , return back to Sonprayag /Guptkashi and take some rest. Dinner and Overnight stay at the hotel.



Day 9: (Sonprayag / Guptkashi –Joshimath :210 Kms 07 - 08 Hrs Approx.)

Drive towards Badrinath, en-route watch the lush green mountains. Have healthy meals during your journey. Reach Badrinath by evening after freshanup reached shree Badrivishal temple Do darshan be the part of evening aarti at shree Badrivishal Temple back to hotel Dinner and overnight stay at Badrinath in Hotel.



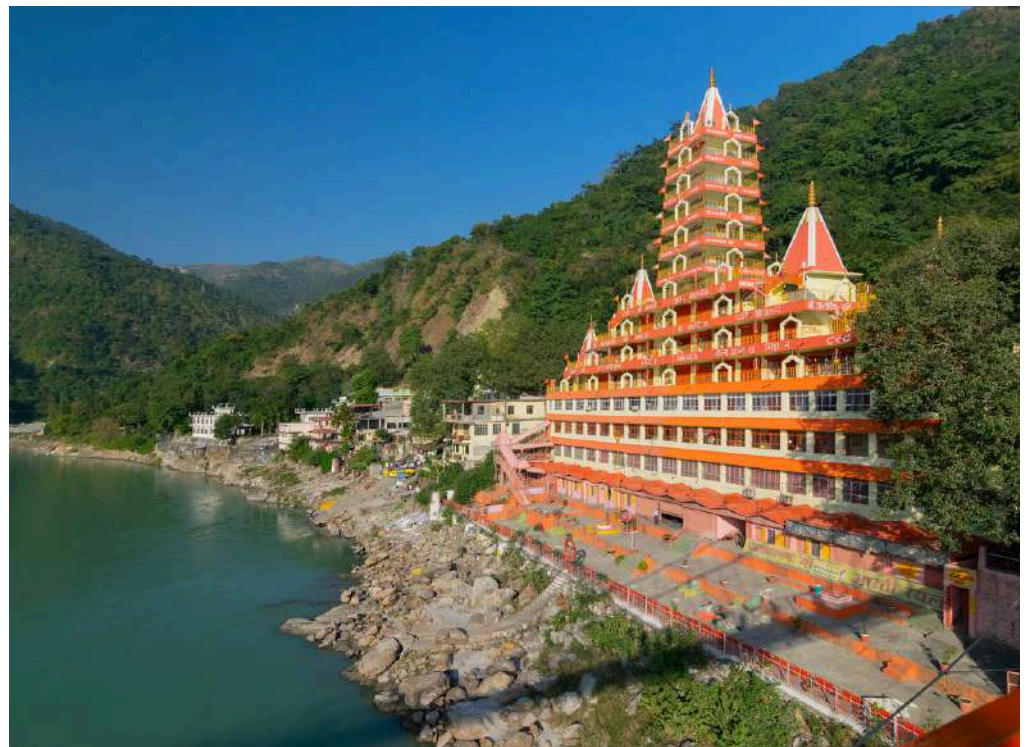
Day 10: (Badrinath / Local Sightseeing – Joshimath): 150 Kms 05-06 Hrs Approx.)

Early morning , visit and pray at the Badrinath Temple for Badri Vishal Darshan. Visit Mana Village also known as The First village of India visit Bheem pul where saraswati river flows. Visit Vyash Guffa, Ganesh Guffa, after exploring Mana village. Drive down to Rudraprayag, en-route see the Sangam of River Mandakini and Alaknanda at Rudraprayag. Dinner and overnight stay at Hotel in Rudraprayag .



Day 11: (Joshimath- Rishikesh) :163 Kms 06-07 Hrs Approx

Drive to Rishikesh en-route see the Sangam of River Bhagirathi and Alaknanda at Devprayag, witness the formation of River Ganga. The Sangam is visible from far, as the water colours of both the rivers vary. We can do darshan at Maa Dhari devi temple. Reach Haridwar check-in Hotel dinner and overnight stay



Day 12: (Rishikesh – Delhi drop: 260 Kms 04-05 Hrs Approx.)

Drive to Delhi and drop at Akshardham Metro Station with wonderful memories.



**** Note: As Chardham is in hilly region the roads here are not in very good conditions. Landslides, road blocks, Delay due to weather are very common in this region. Itinerary is subject to change / modified in case of unavoidable reasons. In case of any additional delay/ additional days during the yatra would be self-payable**

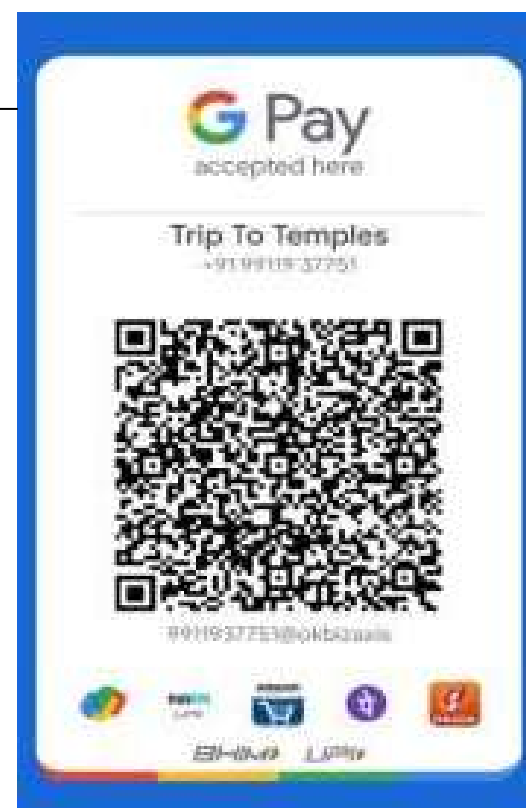

TOUR GUIDELINES

- The car must pass or be checked at the RTO Office (Rishikesh or Haridwar) in accordance with government regulations; depending on the volume of traffic, this process may take some time. We kindly request your cooperation.
- Char Dham is not considered a luxury destination; the resources and amenities available are somewhat limited compared to other Himalayan locations. Nevertheless, we will strive to offer you the best possible services. We kindly request your support and cooperation in this endeavor.
- Residing at Kedarnath Top presents difficulties due to its elevated altitude of approximately 3,583 meters and its restricted operational time frame of six months annually.
- The rooms may seem humid or lack adequate cleanliness, even at a rate of ₹10,000–₹15,000 per room.
- Facilities might not fulfill standard expectations, as it is challenging to maintain resources at this altitude.
- Due to limitations in space, a per-bed-per-person arrangement is in place. Individual roommate preferences cannot be accommodated.

Hotel Availability

- Hotels can be found either in the city or in surrounding areas, depending on what is available. This is arranged for your convenience and to ensure effective logistics. Accommodation fees are contingent upon availability, and alterations at the last minute may take place.

Travel Challenges -

- The distance to Kedarnath is between 18 and 20 kilometers, with all vital supplies also arriving at the temple via this same path.
- It is common to experience traffic delays of 10 to 15 hours in a single day, particularly during the peak season.
- Landslides, climatic conditions, and governmental regulations may additionally affect timelines.
- Helicopter services to Kedarnath are contingent upon weather conditions and may experience cancellations or delays.
- Government taxis (such as those operating from Sonprayag to Gaurikund) are required, and larger vehicles are not permitted to go past Sonprayag. Waiting times could be applicable.

Adjustments to Meal Plans and Timetable:

- Because of early departures or delays, there is a possibility that you will miss meals (breakfast or dinner).
- Refunds will not be granted for meals that are missed.
- Meal arrangements are contingent upon the availability of dining establishments throughout the journey.

Health and Safety

- This pilgrimage is physically demanding. It is essential to ensure that you are medically fit and to consult a doctor if needed.
- Maintain proper hydration, opt for light food, and have medications on hand to prevent altitude sickness.

Travel Insurance - We do not offer insurance services. We highly advise obtaining third-party travel insurance for enhanced security.

Patience & Cooperation:

- This is a Yatra, not a tourist package. Although we strive to give comfort, limiting resources and practical constraints may create difficulty.
- We cannot control force majeure occurrences like landslides, excessive traffic, or poor weather. We kindly seek your cooperation and understanding.

Special Note About Kedarnath Top:

- Kedarnath Top accommodations are not luxury and may not match typical standards. Maintaining amenities is challenging due to the high elevation and large number of pilgrims.
- Even after paying premium rates, you may discover:
 - Damp or dirty rooms
 - Limited facilities.
 - Large crowds and sharing accommodations.
- Despite these limitations, seeing and experiencing the sacred site is a transformational experience.

Final Points to Remember:

- Registration is required for the CharDham Yatra.
- Long queues for Darshan and necessary government inspections (RTO, taxis) are part of the experience.
- Previous experiences predict traffic delays and unexpected weather interruptions, so patience is essential. Our crew aims to make your journey unforgettable while adhering to the Yatra's limitations.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Before the trip can begin, the whole amount must be paid in full. Pending payments may result in the cancellation of the trip.
- All IDs will be validated prior to boarding. No boarding will be permitted without a valid Government ID.

- Chardham is a highly crowded attraction, so expect to wait for up to 3-4 hours at any roadblock.





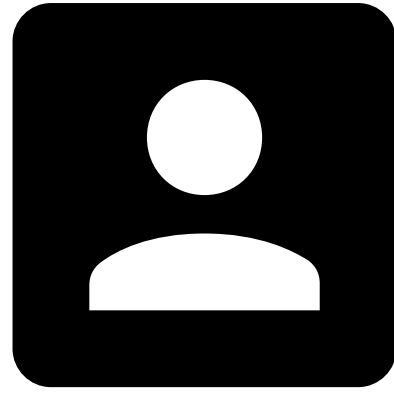

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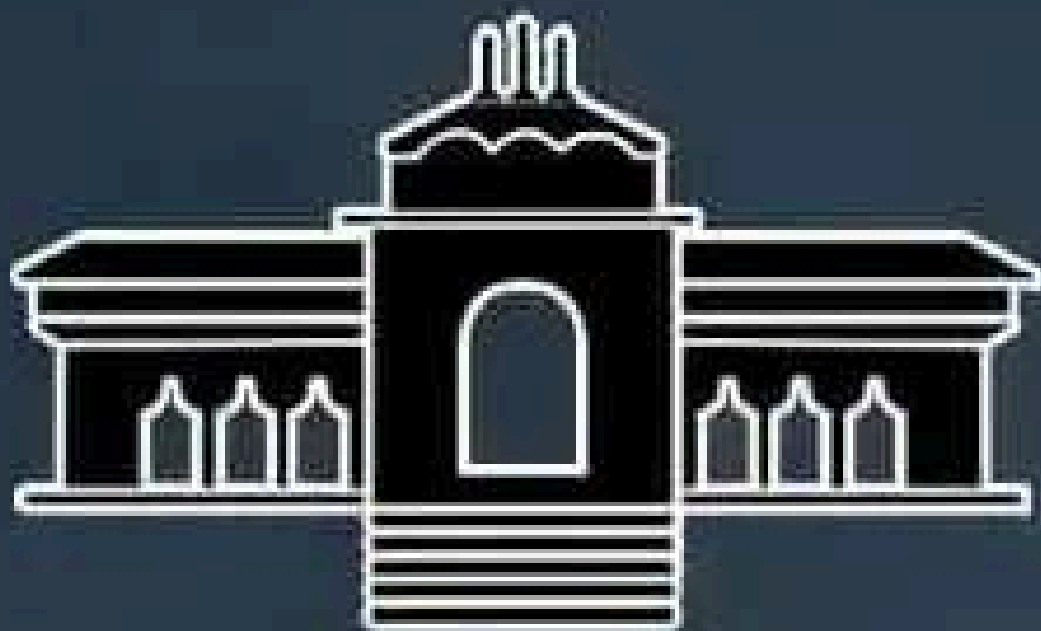
